## Outreach Completes 2011 Grant Funding

The Outreach Committee devoted hundreds of hours this past year reviewing applications for funding from non-profits from around the region and around the world.

The Committee's policy is to spend each year all the funds raised the previous year, thus ensuring they know exactly how many dollars are available to support those in need.

Funds spent on Outreach come from a variety of sources, including: Annual Outreach Golf Tournament; Pledges from All Saints parishioners; and General Donations.

The dollars went to recipients in four categories: local/national, international, unanticipated needs/emergencies; and the Parish Focus Project (which for 2010-11 was People's Self Help Housing.)

A comprehensive Outreach report was distributed at service on Jan. 8 and is now available at the Welcome Table or by calling the Church Office.

## 2012 Pledge Campaign Update

This is the first update to the Parish since our Stewardship Ingathering on Sunday, Oct. 23. Overall, many All Saints families indeed took a "step up" in their giving for 2012. We are especially grateful that one-third of our pledging members increased their giving substantially. We are also heartened by the many new families who have recently joined All Saints and who became significant pledgers for 2012.

We noted that some of our parish families have not yet renewed their pledges for 2012. Pledging is important for many reasons, but not least because it gives Church leadership an indication of the level of financial support it can expect for the coming year. Without this, budgeting the many expenses that go into All Saints' ministries of worship, formation and outreach is difficult.

Church operations are primarily supported by pledge payments, followed by gifts not covered by pledges, then income generated by our endowment and savings. We are very grateful, of course, for the significant financial gifts received in the past year that were not accompanied by pledges, but we do hope that as many of our parish family as possible will help by indicating their intended level of support in the new year. Thank you for your continued support of the mission and ministries of All Saints-by-the-Sea.

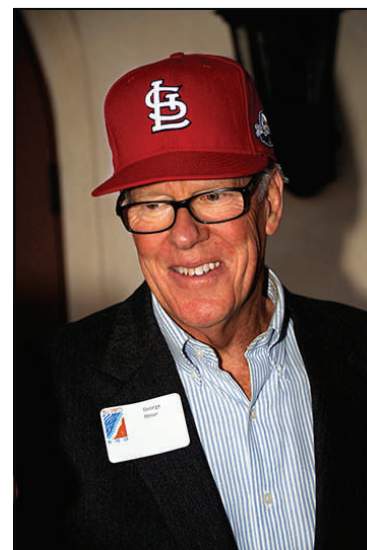
