SPECIAL MUSIC FUND

This summer, All Saints is hearing and singing the music of the Anglican Communion from around the world, as part of our summer Arts in Worship Series. Today is the last Sunday of our three-week focus on the music of Latin America. Starting next week and continuing until July 20 we'll hear the music of Celtic lands, featuring the harp and Irish fiddle. From July 27 to August 10 we'll feature music of "the Islands," welcoming the Caribbean sounds of reggae, jazz, and Hawaiian folk music. Finally, we'll come full circle in August, as we welcome an American Gospel/Bluegrass band much like we featured on Pentecost Sunday.

These professional guest musicians are a particularly welcome addition during the summer when our All Saints Choir rests, but of course, they come at a cost. The fee for these professional artists is approximately \$300 for a Sunday morning, which is paid for in whole by your financial support of our All Saints Special Music fund. Your generous contribution to the fund enables us to invite a wide variety of artists to our worship each year – thank you.

EfM SEMINAR YEAR IS FORMING

Education for Ministry (EfM) will once again be offered in Santa Barbara this year, beginning in September. EfM welcomes all interested, new, and returning participants to participate in this program of theological education at a distance, which originates from the School of Theology at the University of the South in Tennessee. Local groups meet weekly throughout the United States and overseas from September through the following June. Meetings are generally three hours and consist of worship, group study, and theological reflection which is the heart of the program. EfM's mission is to provide an educational foundation and support for all ministries through deepening of faith and understanding of the church, and living theologically in the world.
