LIFE IN CHRIST WITH THE PRAYER OF ST. PATRICK

There are many versions of the Prayer of St. Patrick (of "St. Patrick's Breastplate," as it is also known) but perhaps the best known and most widely accepted section reads:

*Christ be with me, Christ within me,
Christ behind me, Christ before me,
Christ beside me, Christ to win me
Christ to comfort and restore me.
Christ beneath me, Christ above me,
Christ in quiet, Christ in danger,
Christ in hearts of all that love me,
Christ in mouth of friend and stranger.*

Corrie Vande Beek's Fruit Punch Recipe



Melt 2 cups of sugar in 6 cups of water; cool
 Blend: 6-7 bananas, 12 oz. frozen orange juice (thawed), 12 oz. frozen lemon juice (thawed), 46 oz can of pineapple juice
 Add 4-5 qts of ginger ale (at the last minute)
