The Book of Common Prayer: This smaller red book in the pew rack is the principal book of liturgy for Episcopalians. Prayer: You will find that some people stand in prayer while others kneel. On All Saints Sunday we celebrated the culmination of our Annual Giving Campaign by offering our completed pledge cards as an act of worship in grateful response to all God has provided us. The vestry and the stewardship ministry team have set a goal of receiving 100% of pledge commitments from our worshiping community. # LIVING GENERQUSLY STEWARDSHIP UPDATE

As of noon Thursday, December 15th, we have received 165 pledges in support of All Saints' ministries in 2017, adding up to \$702,091. For those who have pledged for both 2016 and 2017, 2017 pledges are running about 2% above those for 2016. Included in the 165 figure are ten pledges totaling \$41,750 from families that did not pledge for 2016. Thank you for giving to support our life-sustaining ministries.
