### COLUMBARIUM NICHES, MEMORIAL PLAQUE DRAWING HELD LAST MONTH — SEE REVERSE FOR DRAWING ORDER

Members of the parish gathered on the patio last month to witness names being drawn to determine the order that families would choose their columbarium niche or memorial plaque.

Over the past several months, families informed the Church Office if they would like to have their ashes interred in the Memorial Chapel, which will be constructed as part of the All Saints Sanctuary Preservation and Readiness Project. Memorial Plaques will include the names of family members who may be interred elsewhere.

Approximately 80 families expressed interest in niches while roughly 35 families requested space on memorial plaques.

Kathleen Winters from the Church Office will now contact each family in the order that their name was drawn to confirm their interest, the number of niches/plaques, process contractual documents and payment, and help families choose the location that their loved one will be interred or plaque location.

### SIX-MONTH COUNTDOWN TO CHURCH CLOSURE BEGINS!

The countdown is on: we've secured our main use permits and raised the funds, we know where we'll worship and we have our schedule: the next 6 months will see a flurry of work to get ready to close the Sanctuary for its 20-month renovation!:

- ◆ Finalize plan to update, ready the Parish Hall
- ◆ Determine approach to worship
- ◆ Conduct bidding process for moving/storage/shipping companies; organ removal plan
- ◆ Conduct bidding process to choose general contractor — see article on right
- ◆ Close and move everything in the Sanctuary
- ◆ Keep the parish, Parish School families and neighbors updated on the project

### GENERAL CONTRACTOR BIDDING PROCESS BEGINS

The process to secure competitive bids from area general contractors begins intensively in the coming weeks.

Several contractors from the greater Central Coast region have been contacted to determine their interest to participate in an informational meeting about our project.

From these one-on-one meetings, which will take place in early and mid-November, it is envisioned that

three to four will be invited to submit detailed construction bids based on



the final construction drawings, which were submitted to Santa Barbara County for plan check this past week.

Contractors will have January through March 2018 to prepare their detailed bids, including for all subcontractors. The project committee will review submissions in April and recommend a contractor to the Vestry in May. The Sanctuary "evacuation" will occur in April and May and the contractor will formally begin work in early June.
