Sunday Worship Cancelled at All Saints; Please Attend Trinity Santa Barbara, All Saints "Home Church" in Carpinteria, or St. Paul's Ventura

The All Saints campus and Parish School continue to be inaccessible and in need of some clean-up after its use as a medical triage area and evacuation center (please see yesterday's "Bell Tower" for the complete story). Rev. Aimee, Alyson, our neighbors who were at home, and a few parishioners who live nearby performed heroic work to treat, feed, clothe and shelter many who were injured or unable to get out on Tuesday.
