## ALL SAINTS CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Il Saints Church and School leaders continue discussing necessary plans to reduce the scope of the Sanctuary renovation plans that address seismic retrofitting of the 118-year-old structure. Construction costs exceeded the Church budget, requiring downsizing plans which will likely mean less impact on the School:

- Less excavation and renovation: no new basement/less demolition
- Little if any re-roofing work
- Elimination of the addition into the area where the School swing set is now located
- No demolition, reconstruction of the building wing located on the ocean side of the Church
- Other reductions in project scope

While no decisions have been made by church leaders, if these efforts are adopted there could be far fewer impacts on the Parish School and playground. In fact, if the current vision of a smaller project is adopted, there would be no permanent change to the Parish School playground.

While the exact construction start date not been set, construction will occur

during the 2018-19 school year. A benefit of a smaller project is a significantly shorter construction schedule.
