

All Saints Sanctuary Renovation: Parish School Information/Update

May 29, 2019

- Armstrong Associates fully mobilized April 3rd.

Since that time they have done demolition of walls, floor and some roof area. Shoring of the roof and remaining structure has occurred simultaneously.

- Armstrong has discovered one additional transite flue that requires hazardous material remediation and removal. The material is not friable and does not require “tenting”. This hazardous materials work will be completed while the Parish School is not in session on June 5–10, between the end of the regular school year and start of summer session. All hazardous materials work will completed by VenTerra Environmental Inc.

- It has become necessary, during the renovation, for the red playhouse in the North portion of the Parish School playground to be moved and the section of wood fence behind it moved forward (in line with the remainder of the North playground section of fence). See attached diagram. This will occur when school is out June 5–10.

- Looking forward to June 15th – Armstrong Associates will continue with demolition and shoring. The demolition of old foundation will be a focus with continued interior demolition. Concrete work is scheduled to begin May 28th with framing and pouring new foundation and footings.



- Armstrong is using appropriate dust control measures. Workers in direct proximity to demolition materials do wear dust masks. Armstrong is ensuring that dust is contained to the construction site. See attached photo.

- 4 access routes to Parish Hall & Parish School when

Construction Fence in place & North Parking Lot closed:

- from lot north of Friendship Center & Office along edge of Construction Fence
- from lot south of Office past front of Parish House
- from entrance of lot south of Parish House to front of Parish House
- from end of lot south of Parish House to walkway west of School
